Considering the recent events regarding COVID-19's development, Universidade de Lisboa decided to implement a set of measures aimed to preventing the spread of the virus.

In this regard, all Schools have suspended their face-to-face teaching, replacing them, whenever possible, with other learning options allowing the monitoring of all school activities, such as .online teaching/classes.

Libraries, study halls and the Social Services' dining halls also suspend their activities.

The University Stadium of Lisbon and the university's Schools, sports and physical activities are suspended or restricted, particularly those taking place in closed venues.

Students accommodated in the ULisboa's Halls of Residence, which are not required to attend face-to-face activities in their Schools will be advised to return home. The halls of residence will ensure support for -specific cases.

Group activities carried out in the university's museums and their botanical gardens are also suspended. The facilities will remain open to the public, for individual visitors.

Remote work will be put into place whenever possible, in order to guarantee the university's basic activities. Bearing in mind the society's protection, all travel is canceled until further notice.

Self-isolation should be upheld by all those considered suspect cases, including those returning from affected areas-/. These measures are in effect for the next two weeks and will be adapted according to the evolution of the epidemiological situation .
